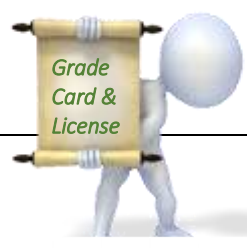

Initially the event will be run as a Jackpot event with a fine perpetual trophy donated by Bob & Jan.



The event will be a 4-person team open to TR and F-Disciplines.

Competition: 2 sighters and 10 counting shots

- Friday PM 700m & 800m, Monday at the conclusion of the Queens 900 m
- Each Member of the team will take their individual Queens score + their teams score for the Teams Aggregate.

Rules: 4-person team from any district in Australia

- Coach can be a shooter in the team or a coach from anywhere in Australia
- TR can be from any grade
- F-Disciplines - a maximum of 2 FO per team – any grade
- The competition will be conducted under SSR's

Entry & Prizes: \$200 entry per team

- Winning team to collect 70% + Trophy + prize
- Highest individual score 20%
- NTRA 10%



We are hoping for a minimum of 10 teams in each discipline. The Queens is now a 10-range aggregate and with the inclusion of The Dyer we will have a great chance in showcasing some great shooting.
